

## Airport Managers' Notice

The Commemorative Air Force's Airsho will take place at the Midland International Air & Space Port (MAF) from August 28-30, 2015. Airport surface closures will be in place during this time for the safety of aerobatic performers, tenants, and spectators. Safety is our top priority, and these airfield closures ensure safety before, during, and after airshow events. A Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) will also be in place during aerobatic demonstrations. The TFR will be applicable from the surface to 17,500' AGL, within a five (5) nautical mile radius of MAF. Expected airport closure times are listed below. MAF will be closed to all traffic during the aerodrome closure periods. The only exceptions will be included in additional NOTAMS with specific times. The TFR and NOTAMS may be cancelled prior to the times indicated.<sup>i</sup>

### Runway and Taxiway Closures

- Runway 10/28 will be closed between Tuesday, August 18, and Sunday, August 23, for the installation of a Temporary Arresting Gear System. Once the installation is complete, the runway will be re-opened until Friday, August 28. The Arresting Gear System will be in place through the completion of the airshow.
- Taxiway 'A' east of the Taxiway 'A' Run-Up Pad will be closed beginning Tuesday, August 25, at 0800L until further notice. Aircraft taxiing to and/or from the West Executive Ramp will be required to proceed westbound on Taxiway 'A' then proceed eastbound on Runway 10/28. *During the waiver times (listed above) the entirety of Taxiway 'A' will be closed.*
- Taxiway 'E' will be closed beginning Tuesday, August 25, from 0800L until further notice.
- Taxiway 'B' between Taxiway 'F' and Runway 10/28 will be closed beginning Wednesday, August 26, at 1000L until further notice.
- The west 100 feet of Taxiway 'P' will be closed between Taxiway 'H' and Runway 10/28 beginning Thursday, August 27, at 0800L until further notice. Aircraft utilizing Taxiway 'P' should taxi east of the Taxiway centerline.
- The west 3,000 feet of Runway 10/28 will be closed except for taxiing operations beginning Friday, August 28, from 1000L until further notice.

<sup>i</sup> All traffic should expect a short delay each day following the conclusion of aerobatic activities. Airport Operations will be conducting an Airfield Safety Inspection to ensure the safety of airport users. **All traffic must remain clear of all Runways and Taxiways until otherwise advised.**
